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ADMISSIONS

The Doctor of Ministry Degree is a professional degree open to all clergy in active ministry who have:

- A Master of Divinity degree from an institution accredited by the Association of Theological Schools
- A Master of Divinity GPA of 3.0 (B) or better
- Three or more years in an active ministry setting
- A strong record of leadership and previous study

Tuition, Room & Board

Educational Design

The Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) degree is an intensive program that requires 30 credit hours of course work, a project paper agreed upon by the director.

Students must maintain a grade average of B - (minus) or better to remain in the program. Students will participate in courses offered primarily in one-week time-frames.

The D.Min. degree is structured to be completed in three years, however students may take up to six years. Once students have completed the project seminar they will be assigned a project reader to guide them during the writing process.

Housing

Limited dormitory-style housing is available for Doctor of Ministry students during the January and May intensive terms. Students request housing during the DMin Housing Application Window for each term; rooms are then assigned on a first-come basis. The housing office will assist students with suggestions of other accommodations if necessary.
