Borrowing Privileges

Wesley students may borrow up to seventy-five (75) items for the duration of the current semester. You may renew a book two times before it is due back to the library. Please return or renew books by the due date(s) to avoid overdue fines.

Course Reserves

The library ensures access to most required class readings by placing the books on Course Reserves. We try to have electronic copies (eBooks) of Course Reserves titles if they are available on our platform. Online Resources

While on campus or off campus, Wesley students have full access to the library's online resources (e.g., AtlaSerials PLUS, other databases, ejournals, and eBooks). Off-campus access requires your My Wesley username and password. Interlibrary Loan (ILL) & Document Delivery

To request a book or article that we do not own from another library, use the ILL form available through the library webpage. Go to the library webpage. Go to the "Library Services" section and click on the "ILL and Document Delivery" link or use the direct URL: <u>https://wesleyseminary.libguides.com/library_operations_services/ILL-Document-Delivery</u>.

ILL requests can take 7-10 business days to arrive in the mail, although journal articles may arrive more quickly as PDFs via email. Currently, rush ILL request processing is not an available service.

American University & the Washington Theological Consortium

Students can obtain borrowing privileges at American University and the libraries of the Washington Theological Consortium (WTC). For American University, take your Wesley photo ID card to the Bender Library to establish a borrower's account. For the WTC, obtain a WTC borrowing form from our library each semester. Take the form and your Wesley ID to a WTC library to borrow books. Borrowing privileges vary based upon the policies of each WTC library.
